## Kitchen Corner—Turkey/Chicken Tetrazzini

---

So holiday time is fast-approaching. In this issue of the Club Kitchen, I'd like to cover a tasty recipe for that leftover turkey. This recipe was a family tradition in our house and my family would make it throughout the year with either chicken or turkey. I'll list the ingredients and then give you some options.

2-3 lbs of either chicken or turkey on the bone

2 green peppers, diced

2 medium onions, diced

1 16-22 oz jar roasted red peppers, chopped

8-12 oz bacon

1 pint mushrooms (optional), chopped

2 15 oz cans cream of mushroom soup

Locatelli Romano cheese

2 lbs thin spaghetti

Take a large stockpot and place the turkey carcass in covered with water.

If you're substituting chicken, I find split chicken breasts with the bone work well. Bring to a boil and simmer for 2-3 hours. Remove carcass and meat, pick the meat, cut it up and set aside. Save the broth for later. If you don't have the time to make broth from the carcass, 2 quarts of chicken broth work well. Cut up the bacon into small pieces and place in another large pot. Render bacon out over medium heat until crispy. Remove bacon and set aside while leaving the fat in the pot. Add one ladle of the broth to the fat to deglaze. Now add the green peppers and onion and sauté until softened. At this time you can add the chopped red peppers to the pot. My mother always found that roasted red peppers always added a richer flavor to the dish. It is at this time you can add the mushrooms if you choose. Continue cooking until the mushrooms are soft. While the mushrooms are softening, add water to the broth to total about 4 quarts, and bring to a boil. Once boiling, add the spaghetti by breaking it into thirds and dropping it in. While spaghetti is

cooking, add cream of mushroom soup to the vegetables, return the bacon and chicken/turkey and mix well. Now it's time to add the cheese. I start with 6 heaping tablespoons, incorporating it well. The exact amount is personal preference but as a person once told me, when you think you have enough cheese, add a little more. Once pasta is cooked to your liking, remove from the broth and add to the vegetable mixture. Be sure to save some broth to thin out the tetrazzini as needed. Serve with crusty bread. Yum!

This dish grows in flavor when reheated the next day and freezes well. You will need some leftover broth when reheating. Take note that I added no seasonings. The turkey carcass may have been injected and/or well-seasoned when originally cooked so taste the dish first and then add salt and pepper to your liking. Enjoy your holidays and happy eating!

It was agreed that this would require a professional Engineering Company. The LUC is always looking for new ideas from our membership, remember, SCSC belongs to ALL of us. It's future is up to all of us.





1. Be sure that you carry your membership cards while you are on club property, anyone may ask to see it if you are not recognized. Additionally, range badges are required to be worn on all ranges. Please be sure to have yours on while on the property.
